Why Love Island?

It's become the cultural moodboard for Summer 2025.

- #2 most-streamed original series in the U.S. the week of June 9 (Deadline).
- 54M social interactions across Instagram, Facebook, X, and YouTube.
- #Lovelsland has over 1.6M posts on TikTok.
- 30% mobile viewership signals a young, highly engaged digital audience.
- Viewers create memes, reactions, POV edits that spill into real-life convo.
- Popular phrases: "I've got a text," or "Can I pull you for chat," = everyday slang

Love Island x Love, Bekah =

- Love Island is a mirror for modern romance: chaotic, cheeky, emotional.
- It reflects the same themes our cards tap into: ghosting, glow-ups, and self-love.
- Viewers are not just watching; they're processing their own love lives through it.



"Pull You for a Chat?" Carousel

Card deck as convos you wish you could have:

- Slide 1: "Can I pull you for a chat?"
- Slide 2: "You were never asking for too much you were asking the wrong person.
- Users may send these to each other through DM



I've Got a Card!

Format: Reels/TikToks, POV style

- Dramatic zoom-in or "ding" text sound
- Open a Love, Bekah card like it's a Love Island text
- Voiceover or onscreen text reveals the message


Example Copy:

Love Island tension music


"I've got a card."

Hot Girl Healing Toolkit

■ Love, Bekah card	For the closure she gave <i>herself</i> — or the love letter she's writing to her bestie
Lip gloss or balm	Healing, but make it glossy — because we take care of ourselves inside and out
Mini journal or sticky notes	For morning thoughts, mantras, or brain dumps — emotional hygiene, but cuter
♪ Playlist screenshot	Show her "soft reset" summer playlist (RAYE, Sabrina Carpenter, Cleo Sol, etc.)
Body oil or perfume	Because healing smells like vanilla, coconut, or whatever her main character scent is
A ring or crystal	Optional, but adds personality/aesthetic — something symbolic she "carries" with her
Polaroid or photobooth strip	Bonus: include a pic of her and a friend, or solo joy moment




